The educational program began with a discussion on elements that make us of "Fundamentally Human" and offered a close look at the human brain. Apart from natural reflexes such as blinking and breathing, as well as automatic actions like walking and eating, the program focused on cognitive processes like remembering the past and dreaming. The program also demonstrated how different artists created objects of art based on these concepts.

The workshop segment of the program encouraged children to draw their own world based on the central nervous system. Designed for primary school students, the program is offered to groups of 15 or less participants.
